Jefferson County Courthouse	Glass Brick	The glass brick in the Courthouse steps marks where the lake's water line would be without the Dike that Saved Dandridge.
Roper Mansion	Fire	Jac's Mark. Alchemical symbol for fire. Red triangle.
Dandridge Brewing Company	Tumeric	Herb used for cooking, but also used by Evangeline to save the lives of Jessie Lee and JoJo in Graveyard Alley.
City Barber Shop	Barber Pole	White pole with blue and red stripes.
Martha's Market	Wand of Fire	The Wand that Jac pulls from the broken crystal ball in Graveyard Alley II.

Tracee's Treasures	Key of Air	The Key that Jessie Lee pulls from the broken crystal ball in Graveyard Alley II.
Dandridge Visitors Center	Silver Ladle	The Silver Ladle that JoJo pulls from the broken crystal ball in Graveyard Alley II.
Revolutionary Graveyard	Maple Tree	The biggest, oldest tree in the graveyard. Eva falls from this tree in Graveyard Alley II.
Shepard Inn	Mounting Block	Felicity learns the purpose of these tall stones from Jim in Graveyard Alley II. Related to horses.
The Writer's Cabin	Water	JoJo's mark. Alchemical symbol for water. Blue upside down triangle.
The Co-Op Barn	Spirit	Preview for Graveyard Alley III. Alchemical symbol for Spirit. Purple swirl.
Harris Family Cemetery	Earth	Felicity's Mark. Alchemical symbol for earth. Green, upside down triangle with a line.
Tinsley Bible	Photo of Peggy	Mrs. Peggy pictured with CL Giles holding a copy of Graveyard Alley.
The Unkind Raven	The Book	The Book Felicity finds in the Dandridge Memorial Library in Graveyard Alley. Old, worn magical book that writes its own pages.
